SUBJECT: Preregistration for Summer/Fall 2009

This memorandum provides information and instructions concerning preregistration for:

- First Summer Session and 10-week Summer Term 2009
 - Preregistration, March 23 - April 3
- Second Summer Session 2009
 - Preregistration March 23 - April 3
- Fall 2009
 - Preregistration April 16 - May 1

Students who are on scholastic probation, or are not enrolled in junior level or senior level PETE classes this semester have been blocked and must see me for advising before preregistration (See list at Enclosure 1). The purpose of advising is to assist in the development of a valid degree plan independent of the summer/fall schedule. Your plan should be based on your catalog, which can be found by logging into <https://myrecord.tamu.edu/> and clicking on degree audit request.

Due to recent changes in course offerings, both at the college and departmental levels, you may need to adjust your degree plan to reflect expected course availability. The updated Curriculum in Petroleum Engineering and Course Descriptions (including prerequisites) are posted at http://people.tamu.edu/~bmaggard/Advising/Pre-registration_09C.

Students not on the Registration Block List may pre-register, but should note the following:

- PETE students who have completed PETE 225, COMM 205, MEEN 221, MEEN 227/MEEN 315, CVEN 305, MATH 308, and PETE 311. Register for Junior 1, Junior 2 or Junior 3 schedule. **DO NOT MIX**. See Enclosure 2. If you are unable to register for all courses in Junior 1, Junior 2 or Junior 3, please contact Mrs. Gail Krueger. **(repeat DO NOT MIX)** See Enclosure 2.
- PETE students who have not completed PETE 225, COMM 205, MEEN 221, MEEN227/MEEN 315, CVEN 305, MATH 308 and PETE 311. Register for sophomore engineering courses as appropriate. See Enclosure 3.

Most students will be able to complete preregistration advising by e-mail. Provide a spreadsheet that shows all of your completed and planned coursework, arranged by semester (from beginning to graduation). Submit to maggard@pe.tamu.edu.

Students will be unblocked for preregistration upon approval of their submitted degree plan and submission of an updated internship job survey form. Students needing to meet for advice on their degree plan may schedule an appointment through Mrs. Gail Krueger [Room 501R, 845-6955, or gail@pe.tamu.edu] provided they have completed the internship job survey form.
